My child feels safe at this school	97% Agree or Strongly Agree	You tell us your children feel safe at school. We will continue to address any areas of unacceptable behaviour which can impact on children's wellbeing and learning.
The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved	97% Agree or Strongly Agree	Mostly, you agree that behaviour is good and that we deal with any bullying quickly and effectively.
The school deals with the bullying quickly and effectively	6% said children had not been bullied 76% Agree or Strongly Agree 12% Disagreed or strongly disagreed 6% Did not know	You have asked that there is consistency in the way we deal with behaviour issues. We do have a school-wide behaviour policy which we follow but we will ensure all staff are using it consistently. Every incident of bullying is dealt with. We will also ensure that incidents are dealt with promptly and that we keep parents informed of what is happening and what we are doing to address issues.
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.	6% Had not raised concerns with the school 79% Agree or Strongly Agree 3% Disagreed 12% Did not know	As will behaviour, we do deal with all issues raised but we will continue to ensure this is done promptly to try to avoid any repetition of incidents.
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year	100% Agree or Strongly Agree	You agreed that we kept you informed of what your children were learning and that we had high expectations for children. Some parents feel there should be more real-life experiences. We build these in as much as we can within the topics set out in the National Curriculum.
My child does well at this school	94% Agree or Strongly Agree 3% Disagreed 3% Did not know	Some parents would like more academic challenge. The needs of all pupils are catered for during lessons and that includes providing challenge to ensure children achieve as well as they can. Our outcomes at Year 6 demonstrate that we do deliver academic challenge.
The school has high expectations for my child	88% Agree or Strongly Agree 6% Disagreed or Strongly Disagreed 6% Did not know	You tell us that you welcome the parent consultation evenings to discuss progress and the curriculum update letters. Some parents would like more information chats with teachers.

The curriculum at the school is engaging, broad and balanced	91% Agree or Strongly Agree 6% Disagreed or Strongly Disagreed 3% Did not know	We continue to review our curriculum to ensure it is relevant, ambitious and exciting and that it prepares children for the next stage of their education. We have reviewed it, and continue to do so, to ensure that it is diverse and reflects the cultures of our school.
The school provides opportunities for after school clubs	82% Yes 18% No	Some parents would like a wider range of clubs and clubs that are available to younger children. We continuously try to broaden the range of clubs available but often, take up is low and it is not viable to continue them, particularly if these are offered by external providers. This was the case with afterschool care when it was provided at the school. We will look at more opportunities for younger pupils.
The school supports my child's wider personal development	91% Agree or Strongly Agree 9% Disagree	Although the majority of parents felt we supported the children's personal development, a few felt we could offer more trips. We ensure all classes have the opportunity to attend trips every year as well as enrichment opportunities such as workshops in school.
The school is inclusive and promotes diversity	91% Agree or Strongly Agree 9% Disagree	You tell us that we are an inclusive school that promotes diversity and that we have made improvements in this area. We will look how we can ensure that a wider range of parents can participate in the dialogue about promoting diversity.

The school communicates well with parents, carers and the community	94% Agree or Strongly Agree 6% Disagree	We have been working to give you as much notice of events as possible. Sometimes, we recognise that we do not give you as much notice as possible and we will continue to strive to send messages well in advance of events. We will keep WEDUC and the calendar up-to-date so all information is in the same place. Please do keep an eye on WEDUC.
